CAMP INFORMATION

FACULTY: SWOSU Music Instructor, Lesley Friend, SWOSU Theater Faculty, and prestigious Oklahoma directors and teachers.

DESCRIPTION: The SWOSU Musical Theatre Camp is designed for children who love to sing, dance, act, and perform on stage. Campers will participate in a variety of activities, including vocal coaching, dance workshop, monologue masterclasses, audition techniques, solo and group performance and more. We can't wait to see your child shine!

ELIGIBILITY: Any student completing grades 4-12 may attend with the signature of their parents.

ENROLLMENT: The enrollment application with a \$145.00 tuition payment should be sent by June 10. The payment may be paid by check, credit card (via SWOSU Marketplace), or cash.

ROOM AND MEALS: Dormitory students may pay \$150.00 room and meals fee by mail (with the required \$145 tuition deposit) or at registration on the first day of camp. Commuter students may purchase individual meals if desired for \$10.50. All meals will be served in the Student Union Cafeteria. The first meal will be served on Sunday, June 16, at 5:00 PM.

DORMITORIES: Students will be housed in University dormitories. SWOSU students will serve as counselors and will be supervised by adult faculty members. Single Rooms will be available for an additional \$100.00.

REGISTRATION: You should plan to arrive on campus between 1:00 and 2:00 p.m. Sunday, June 16, 2024. If for any reason you plan to arrive later, please let us know. Upon arrival please go to the Fine Arts Building to register. At that time you will need the following:

- \$150.00 room and board fee, which includes a \$10.00 dorm key deposit, if not previously paid. The \$10.00 dorm key deposit will be returned to you on Wednesday after your room is cleaned, checked, and your key is returned to the counselors.
- 2. Your health form if not previously completed.

Cash, Check, Certified funds are accepted at registration. Credit Card payments can be made before hand or on site by going to the following site https://bit.ly/swosucamppayment and click on *Music Camps Payment Only* product. From there, enter the amount you wish to pay, add to your cart, complete the application information, and enter your credit card information

WHAT TO BRING:

- Sheets for single bed, pillow, and pillowcases, blanket, soap, towels, washcloth, etc.
- Portable fan (All of the rooms are air-conditioned but air-conditioning is unpredictable)
- Sport clothes (jeans, shorts, etc.), that <u>conform to your school's dress code</u>, for daily wear; swim suit
- Jeans or black pants with a SOLID colored t-shirt for Wednesday afternoon performance
- Spending money for snacks

CAMP OFFICE: The camp office, which opens June 3, is located in Fine Arts Center 103. The camp office telephone number will be (580) 774-3296 (will not be active until June 3).

CHECK-OUT: The camp will end on Wednesday, June 19th, after the final concert, which will be held in the Music Building or Hilltop Theater Wednesday afternoon. You may check out of the dorm before your performance, from 12:30-1:30. Rooms will be available in the Fine Arts Building for luggage and equipment during the concert.

REFUNDS: The tuition payment is refundable by written request postmarked on or before June 10. The \$145.00 tuition payment will not be refunded after that date for any reason. Room and meal payments are refundable due to medical reasons until 5:00 PM of the first day of the camp. After that time no refunds will be issued. **The university will need name, address, and phone number of the person requesting the refund in order to process any refunds.**
