## CAMP INFORMATION

**FACULTY:** SWOSU Voice Professors, Dr. Daniel Farris, Dr. Robin Griffeath, and Dr. Kristin Griffeath

**ELIGIBILITY:** Any choir student completing grades 6-12 may attend with the signature of their parents.

**SENIOR HIGH:** Senior High campers will learn the 2021-2022 OkMEA All-State Audition Music. Students will learn technical aspects of the songs as well as foreign language pronunciation and singing technique. Campers will also work on solo voice works and techniques. All classes and sessions will be virtually held via Zoom.

**JUNIOR HIGH:** Junior High campers will sing selections from the Western Oklahoma, Central Oklahoma and All-OCDA Junior High Choir audition music. Campers will also work on solo voice works and techniques. All classes and sessions will be virtually held via Zoom.

**ENROLLMENT:** The enrollment application should be turned in and the \$75 camp fee paid by Wednesday, June 9th. The payment may be paid by credit card (via Touchnet). Credit Card payments can be made before hand by going to the following site
