CAMP INFORMATION- Safety Protocols

Masks: All students, staff, and faculty will be required to wear a mask at all times while on campus. Students will be allowed to remove masks when playing their instruments, rehearsals, classes, etc., eating, and in their dorm room alone or with assigned roommate.

Hand and Classroom Sanitizing: Hand sanitizer will be available throughout each building and will be strongly encouraged for all students and staff to use frequently throughout the day. Rooms will be sanitized after classes and rehearsals.

Rehearsals, Sectionals, and Classes: All rehearsals, sectionals, and classes will be conducted as safe as possible. Most classes will be limited to allow for social distancing and rehearsals and sectionals will be in spaces that allow for social distancing while playing. Large rehearsal spaces will also have open ventilation and rehearsal times will be altered with time for air filtration between classes.

Group Meetings and Evening Activities: All group meetings and evening activities will be socially distanced and/or outside.

Contact Tracing: All rehearsals, sectionals, and elective classes will keep accurate seating charts in the event contact tracing must take place.

Dormitories: SWOSU Music Camps will strictly adhere to all SWOSU Residence Life safety protocols and guidelines. Students will be assigned a roommate based on their listed roommate preference. If no roommate preference is listed students will be randomly assigned another student from the same school. If there is not another student from the same school, students will be randomly assigned another student from a different school. If the student or parent is uncomfortable with being randomly assigned a roommate, they may check on their application, the single room preference for an additional fee of \$75.

Meals: SWOSU Music Camps will strictly adhere to all SWOSU Cafeteria and Auxiliary Services safety protocols and guidelines. All food will be served by SWOSU cafeteria staff members. All students and staff will eat while social distanced and with a limited number in the cafeteria at a time with extended and/or staggered meal times to allow plenty of time to eat.

Social Distancing: SWOSU Music Camps staff and faculty will be monitoring, adhering, and enforcing social distancing in all classes and rehearsals and during camper free time. Traffic flow between classes will be directed and marked according to location.

Camper and Parent Acknowledgement: All campers and their parents must sign the application understanding the risk and agreeing to adhere to all COVID protocols.

Registration, Check In, & Check Out: There will be a limited number allowed in the Fine Arts Auditorium and Dormitories at check in and check out. Social distancing signs and traffic flow signs will be posted and everyone must wear a mask while in the buildings. The final concerts will be live streamed on Zoom or recorded and posted to YouTube with links being sent out to the email address on file with the application.
